Economic Development Liaison, South Lincoln County, Wyoming (Contract Position)

Job Purpose

TerraPower's announcement to construct the Natrium™ Advanced Nuclear Reactor has generated great interest in Kemmerer, Diamondville, and South Lincoln County Wyoming. Local officials are receiving calls from developers, businesses, and media to learn more about the region. This contract position will work with all interested parties--TerraPower, Rocky Mountain Power, ExxonMobil, Bechtel (the company constructing the reactor), and related subcontractors--to facilitate and coordinate between local officials, agencies, and businesses. The contractor will serve as the region's point person and must be outgoing, have strong people skills, demonstrate public relations finesse, and have a basic understanding of economic development in the region.

Job Duties and Responsibilities

Working closely with leadership from Kemmerer, Diamondville, and Lincoln County officials, the South Lincoln County Economic Development Liaison will:

- Serve as the first point of contact person for all businesses inquiring about the region
- Connect all interested parties to the appropriate city, county, or state department or agency or economic development groups
- Communicate the economic development strategies and opportunities of the region
- Network with local and state officials, state and federal legislators, and private developers
- Identify and apply for appropriate grant opportunities

Required Qualifications

The minimum qualifications to be successful in this position include:

- Associate degree from an accredited institution
- Knowledge of Southwestern Wyoming
- A passion for facilitating the growth of South Lincoln County
